- 2. To declare a minor specialization, the student must complete all sections of this form and sign it.
- 3. The declaration of a minor specialization requires the approval of the academic advisor and the corresponding department chairs. They must sign this form after interviewing the student. When the same academic department offers the student's program of study and the minor specialization, the signature of a second department chair is not required on this form.
- 4. To declare a minor specialization and have it certified on the transcript, the student must pay a nonrefundable \$10.00 fee at the Bursar's Office and submit this form to the Office of the Registrar on one of the campuses authorized to offer the minor specialization.
- 5. Students must declare a minor prior to applying for graduation.
- 6. Students must complete the requirements for the minor before or at the same time they complete the requirements for the degree.
- Students must make sure they comply with the satisfactory academic progress norms and the maximum time frame for completing their program of study, as well as with the academic norms of the program to which the minor specialization belongs.
- 8. For the minor specialization to be certified, students must pass the courses of the minor with the GPA required by the program of study.
